Climate Change and the Politics of Climate Change (6 October 2022, 15:00-16:30) Main themes: evidence of climate change, climate change and international relations, the multilateral framework to tackle the climate crisis.</p> <p>2. The Geopolitics of Climate Change and of the Energy Transition (6 October 2022, 16:30-18:00) Main themes: impact of the energy transition on global geopolitics (winners and losers), prospects for the phase-out of fossil fuels, the new politics of renewable energy.</p> <p>3. European Climate and Energy Policy (13 October 2022, 15:00-16:30) Main themes: the EU's 2030 Climate and Energy Framework, the European Green Deal, the Fit for 55 and REPowerEU Agendas, the EU's role in the global climate policy agenda.</p> <p>4. Questioning Climate Science? Populism and Climate Change (13 October 2022, 16:30-18:00) Main themes: the politicization of climate change, populist perspectives on climate change, post-truth politics and climate change, civil society for climate action (i.e. Fridays for Future, Extinction Rebellion)</p>
Prerequisiti:	Enrolment in the seminar series is open to master's/laurea magistrale students only (l'attività è riservata ai soli studenti di laurea magistrale).

Obiettivi formativi:	Participants will deepen their knowledge of some of the main themes of international politics concerning climate change, including the geopolitics of the energy transition, European and global policies to tackle climate change and the challenge posed to these policies by populist discourses.
Numero massimo di studenti:	Maximum 25 participants. Students of the Laurea Magistrale in Relazioni Internazionali, Erasmus and international students and then students of other lauree magistrali at the Department of Social and Political Sciences have priority.
